All Trimax mowers have spindles which are belt driven. Belts consume **25% less hp** than shafts and gearboxes and therefore consume less fuel.

DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

Each of the three mowing decks have spindles fitted with LazerBladez™ that have very high spindle speeds which increase the number of cuts per forward metre of travel, giving a finer cut than comparable rotary mowers. Folding for transport and easily towed behind a compact tractor, the Snake is a cost effective alternative to traditional and expensive self-propelled options. Engineered with a low centre of gravity and with transport locks, road transport of the Snake is safe and easy. The Snake uses a monocoque body construction from 5mm plate steel. A proven and simple belt drive system eliminates the chance of expensive gearbox damage. Automatic belt tensioners ensure maximum drive to the blades at all times.

A stubless roller bearing system for vastly improved roller retention, alignment, bearing life and minimal maintenance



QUIKLIFT

QuikLIFT enables decks to be raised slightly for traversing driveways and paths without the need to disengage the PTO. Also aids in striping.



AUTOMATIC BELT TENSIONERS

Automatic belt tensioners eliminate the need for belt adjustments and improves drive to the spindles and blades.



ARTICULATION ABILITY

With three articulating decks, the Snake has the ability to follow contours and will not scalp at 40mm height of cut.



LAZERBLADEZ"

Available in up-lift and flat formation to suit mowing requirements, the unique tilt forward design minimises hang back in tough conditions.



FULL WIDTH ROLLERS

Full width rollers minimise scalping in undulating conditions and allow mowing over kerbsides, bunkers and potholes.
Also aids in striping.



ZERO TURN

Allows continuous cutting while turning sharply for maximum productivity.



RAPIDSET HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

Clearly displayed stainless steel height indicators allow the easy adjustment of cut heights without having to raise or lower the wings.



The Snake creates **significantly more** updraft than a dedicated self-propelled unit.

- → Large internal baffles provide safety, and control airflow, giving the even cut and spread Trimax is famous for.
- → The shorter blade beams and higher spindle speed means each deck creates a huge amount of updraft, lifting the grass before it's cut and preventing any ugly tractor marks being left behind.
- → Our LazerBladez[™] system has a carefully engineered centre of gravity and a distinctive tilt-forward blade design, offering optimum cut and spread in all conditions.

The wheels and rollers on the gangs used to flatten down the grass but the suction on the Snake cuts that problem out completely. With the Snake we can now cut the rough in 3 or 4 days, giving me an extra man for jobs that would have been left over.



Articulation like no other...

- → Engineered pivot points have been incorporated into the mower design to enable movement in a multitude of directions for extreme contour following.
- → Shorter blade beams allow for a shorter deck (front to rear). This provides greater articulation and allows the machine to closely hug the ground.
- → Full length front and rear rollers support the mower across it's entire width, providing excellent anti-scalp protection.



The Snake's articulation around the greens, bunkers and on the undulating oncourse is first class. There's no sinkage and no damage when turning. It's a truly fantastic machine.




